Abstract: Psychology enjoys the presence of various organisations of an international nature. The International Union of Psychological Science (IUPsysS) comprises well over 80 national members and holds the largest International Congress of Psychology every four years. IUPsysS is committed to the growth of psychology as a science and practice and has engaged in numerous activities globally to promote the further development of psychology, especially in parts of the world where psychology is not prominent. Although eleven Latin American countries are represented in IUPsysS, there is under-representation of Latin American psychological thought in the international arena. This panel, comprising leading psychologists from various parts of the world who have involvement with IUPsysS, will explore why this is so and what can be done to change this state of affairs so that international psychology may benefit from increased exposure to and interaction with psychology in Latin America.
